## UG ADMISSION: 2022-23

### MERIT POINT CALCULATION

- a) Admission will be done on merit basis and merit point for admission in Honours courses is to be calculated by adding 10% of total marks obtained in the best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies at Higher Secondary/equivalent examination and the marks obtained in the subject or related subject in which the admission in Honours course is sought.

<b>Honours Course</b>	<b>Merit point calculation (10% of total marks obtained in the best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies + Marks in following subject)</b>
<b>Anthropology</b>	<b>Maximum of marks in Biology/ English</b>
<b>Economics</b>	<b>Maximum of marks in Economics/ Mathematics</b>
<b>Education</b>	<b>Maximum of marks in Education/ History</b>
<b>Sociology</b>	<b>Maximum of marks in Political Science / History / Psychology/Sociology</b>
<b>Statistics</b>	<b>Maximum of marks in Mathematics/ Statistics</b>
<b>Physics</b>	<b>Physics</b>

- b) The merit points for admission to General courses are to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies of H.S. / equivalent examination.
- c) Candidates who desire to take admission in Tourism and Travel Management (TTM), a self-financed course are advised to visit the page on self-financed courses in the college website for fee structure and other details.

**Note:** If more candidates score same merit point, preference will be given to the one who has scored higher marks in the subject, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same marks in the subject; preference will be given to the candidate who has scored higher marks in 1<sup>st</sup> Language/ 2<sup>nd</sup> Language. If more candidates have same merit points, same marks in the subject and same marks in in 1<sup>st</sup> Language/ 2<sup>nd</sup> Language preference will be given to the candidate who has scored higher marks in the 10 level (Madhyamik/ ICSE/CBSE etc.) Examination. If an applicant gets admission on the basis of higher marks scored in 10 level Examination he/ she is to produce the Mark sheet of the said examination at the time of verification of documents on the date of commencement of classes.
